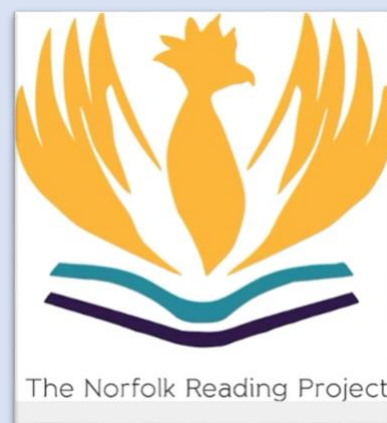


How to get the Most Out of Your TNRP Volunteer

The role of our volunteers is to support the teaching staff. TNRP provides volunteers, trained in current reading practice, who will give additional reading support to those children who need it most.



Our Volunteers

- Are all enhanced DBS checked
- Have basic training in phonics

Volunteers need:

- To have an initial conversation with the class teacher to find out how the reading session will run.
- The teacher to suggest the most efficient time slot to make the best use of the volunteer's time.
- To know which pupils need most help.
- To have a list of their names and levels.
- A system to ensure good feedback to the class teacher - either written or verbal.
- Any SEND or background information that is appropriate for the volunteer to know.

The pupils need:

- Appropriate decodable books for the reading session. These are usually provided by the school.
